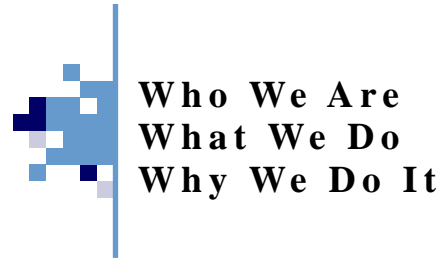
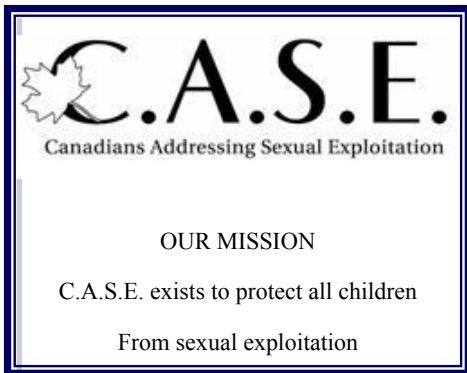




LET YOUR VOICE

FACTS ABOUT PORNOGRAPHY

- ▽ Every second, \$307,564.34 is spent on pornography;
- ▽ Every second, there are 28,258 internet users viewing pornography;
- ▽ Every second, 372 internet users are typing adult terms into search engines;
- ▽ Every 39 minutes, a new pornographic video is being created in the U.S. ¹

Of the thousands of offenders successfully prosecuted for possession of child pornography:

- ▽ 83% had images of children between ages 6 and 12;
- ▽ 39% had images of children between ages 3 and 5;
- ▽ 19% had images of children younger than 3 ²

Child pornography is not pictures of nude children!

Child pornography IS pictures of children being graphically sexually assaulted and raped!

Canadians Addressing Sexual Exploitation (C.A.S.E.) is a national, non-profit organization dedicated to increasing public understanding of the content, effects, and legal issues of sexually explicit and exploitative materials. Through education C.A.S.E. works to inform Canadians of the affects resulting from exposure to these materials.

Our board members are Canadians who have the welfare of children at heart. They are every day people who lobby their local Member of Parliament and the government in power to change laws to protect children; write letters to corporations that exploit children in advertising; write letters to corporations such as the Canadian Radio-Television Corporation to make their views known on regulations and legislative matters.

The C.A.S.E. office is run by volunteers and the executive members of the board. At this time, the total operation is based on monies donated through community organizations and the selling of our Ribbon of Signature kits.
